The CASP International Summit has the following three (3) components:

1. Train to Train Adaptive Snowboard Athlete Development Camp

Where: Whistler Blackcomb Mountain, Whistler, BC

When: Tuesday, March 11 (8:30am) - Wednesday, March 12, 2008 (4pm)

What: Focus on technical training (on and off snow) & competition preparation

- Discipline specialization (Snowboardcross training);
- Core strength & injury prevention;
- High volume, low intensity workloads.

Who: Adaptive Snowboard athletes planning on competing at the WSF Adaptive Snowboard World Cup (athletes competing in the World Cup are recommended to participate in the training camp).

Who: Trained adaptive snowboard coaches are encouraged to shadow the camp.

2. Adaptive Snowboard World Cup
